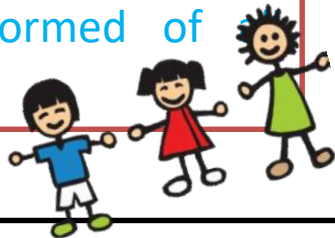

Lunch Boxes & Drink (Please name both especially drinks bottles)
